

He is the only angler to ever win the Bassmaster Classic, Bassmaster Angler of the Year, and the B.A.S.S. Federation Nation Championship. Mike enjoyed an active streak of 19 consecutive Bassmaster Classic appearances. In 2023, Mike's many accomplishments got him inducted into the Bass Fishing Hall of Fame. In addition to competing at the top level of professional bass fishing, Mike is driven to grow the sport of fishing with his own entertainment, education, and charitable organizations. He has established himself as one of the most accomplished, recognizable and respected figures in the sportfishing world.


