Carter Andrews:
The Obsession of Carter Andrews

Renowned angler & guide Carter 'Big Boy' Andrews is plagued by a single obsession: fishing. He cannot remember a time when fishing was not the driving focus of his life. Growing up, he spent countless hours on local ponds with a spinning rig & bait-caster. With dreams of becoming a tournament bass angler, he would likely be on the bass circuit today had a fellow angler not put a fly rod in his hand. In short order, he had a fly-fishing resume that read like a Hall of Famer's: three wins of Jackson Hole One Fly, countless video & print references, a keystone spot on the US Fly Fishing Team... but it was a trip to the Bahamas that introduced him to the world of destination saltwater angling. For the next decade he helped build fishing lodges, train guides & lead exploratory fishing expeditions across the globe. Carter manages nearly 300 days of fishing annually & has earned the reputation of being the most 'complete' angler on the water today.
